## DISAPPEARING HOURGLASS BLOCK

The Disappearing Hourglass block is $10 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ finished = $11^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.

## DIRECTIONS:

1. Begin with four (4) 7" squares - two (2) light and two (2) dark

2. Draw a pencil line on the diagonal of the two (2) light squares.

3. Right sides together, pin in a few places to secure and sew a $1 / 4 \prime$ " seam on each side of the pencil line.

4. Cut both apart on the pencil line creating four (4) half-square triangles (HSTs). Press all four (4) HSTs open toward dark fabric and trim to $6 \frac{1}{4}$ ".

5. Sew four (4) HSTs together into an hourglass block. Press toward dark fabric. Block should measure 12" unfinished.

6. Using a rotary cutter, measure and cut block into nine (9) equal 4" squares (red dashed lines. Leave squares in place as you rotate them as follows in Step 7 and 8.

7. Rotate the eight (8) outside squares $180^{\circ}$. Rotate the center square $90^{\circ}$. Sew squares together using a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam creating a 11" (unfinished) Disappearing Hourglass Block. Press top and bottom rows toward patches 1 and 3. Press center row toward center patch. (Red arrows)
