
Round and Round

FABRIC:

For each quilt block you will need four 5 ½" squares of a background fabric and four 5 ½" squares of a tone one tone solid.


DIRECTIONS:

1. Cut 5 ½"circles out of the tone on tone fabrics.






2. Place two of the 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " circles, right sides together and sew $\frac{1}{2}$ " around the raw edge.




- 3. Cut the circle in half. Trim seam allowance to 1/8" and clip curves. Turn right sides out and press.
- 4. Repeat process making a total of 4 half-circles per block.



5. Place the half circle in between two 5 ½" background squares that have been placed right sides together. Sew ¼" from the edge. Repeat with another half circle and the other 2 background squares to make 2 sections.



6. Place the two sections, right sides together with a half circle between each section as pictured. Sew the two sections together and press circles in opposite directions as pictured, creating a pinwheel block.



To make the quilt pictured you will need:

Pinwheel Fabric: 1 yard

Background Fabric: 1 1/4 yards

Inner Border: ¼ yard Outer Border: 1 yard

Binding: ½ yard

Backing and Batting: 39" x 57" (Approx. 1 2/3 yd.)
