## Wish Upon a Star

34" x 34" Finished

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

Four 10" background squares
Four 10" Fabric A squares
Four 10" Fabric B squares
Inner Border Fabric - 10" cut in four $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips Outer Border Fabric - $16^{\prime \prime}$ cut in four 4" strips


Background Fabric


Fabric A (dark)


Fabric B (light)

## DIRECTIONS:

1. This quilt is made up of:

- Four 6 1/2" (size approx.) background fabric squares
- Four 10 " half square triangles of Fabric A and Fabric B
- Four $10^{\prime \prime}$ half square triangles of Fabric $A$ and Background Fabric
- Four $10^{\prime \prime}$ half square triangles of Fabric B and Background Fabric

2. Cutting and assembling half square triangles.
a. Place a $10^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A (light) square and a $10^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B (dark) square, right sides together.

b. Sew $1 / 41$ around the outside edges as pictured.
c. Cut square on both diagonals creating four $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (approx.) half-square triangles and press toward the darker fabric

3. Repeat the process with $10^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $A$ (light) square and $10^{\prime \prime}$ background square creating 4 Light/Bkgd half square triangles.
4. Repeat the process with $10^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $B$ (dark) square and $10^{\prime \prime}$ background square creating 4 Dark/Bkgd half square triangles.
5. Measure the exact size of the half-square triangles and cut four squares of that measured size from the background fabric.

To help keep quilt top square while assembling blocks, assemble a four-patch block and then sew the four patch blocks together as pictured. (Fig. 1)

## Finishing:

5. Add $2^{\prime}$ (finished) vertical borders first, then $2^{\prime}$ horizontal borders, followed by $31 / 2$ " (finished) vertical borders, then $31 / 2$ " horizontal borders (Fig.2)

-Layer quilt top, batting and backing.
-Quilt as desired.
-Bind edges.

## QUILT VARIATION Create a quilt using 5" Charm Squares

1. Repeat above instructions using 5 " charm squares instead of the 10 " layer cake squares.
2. Create 16 star blocks.

3. You will need sixteen 5 " charm squares. Fabric should be a contrasting fabric to the background fabric. Cut each 5 " charm square into four $21 / 2 "$ squares.

4. Draw a diagonal pencil line on the wrong side of each $21 / 2 \prime$ square. Right sides together, place a $21 / 2 "$ square on each corner of the star square. Sew on the pencil line and trim $1 /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ from the pencil line as pictured.
5. Press corners open.

6. Sew the 16 star squares together - four rows of four star blocks.
7. Add $3^{\prime \prime}$ finished borders to each side of the quilt. Quilt and bind.
