## "X" MARKS THE SPOT

## MATERIALS NEEDED:

For one $121 / 2$ " (unfinished "X Block $A$ ") you will need:
Four (4) $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares of Fabric $A$
Eight (8) $4^{\prime \prime}$ squares of White Background Fabric
Four (4) $3^{\prime \prime}$ squares of Fabric C
Four (4) $3^{\prime \prime}$ squares of Fabric $D$

For one $121 / 2$ " (unfinished "X Block $B$ ") you will need:
Four (4) $61 / 2$ " squares of Fabric B
Eight (8) 4" squares of White Background Fabric
Four (4) $3^{\prime \prime}$ squares of Fabric C
Four (4) $3^{\prime \prime}$ squares of Fabric $D$

For each $121 / 2$ " "X Block $A$ " or "X Block $B$ " you will need to make four (4) $61 / 2$ " squares as follows:
Fabric A: $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square for the center
Background Fabric: Two (2) 4" squares for the white strips
One (1) $3^{\prime \prime}$ square of Fabric $B$ for a corner triangle
One (1) $3^{\prime \prime}$ square of Fabric C for opposite corner triangle


## Directions to make X Block A:

1. On the wrong side of each of the 4 " and 3 "squares, draw a pencil line on the diagonal. (Fig. 1)


2. Place a white $4^{\prime \prime}$ square on the corner of the $6 \frac{112 \prime \prime}{\prime \prime}$ square. Sew on the diagonal pencil line. (Fig. 2)

3. Repeat with another white 4 " square on the opposite corner of the $61 /{ }^{1 \prime \prime}$ square and sew on the diagonal pencil line. (Fig. 3)
4. Trim $1 / 4$ " away from the sewn diagonal pencil line on both corners. (Fig. 4)
5. So that seam will nest together for sewing, always press seams for this block in one direction (red arrows). (Fig. 5)
6. Repeat instructions $2-4$ with the 3 " squares, placing them over the corner white triangles. (Fig. 6) Sew on the diagonal pencil lines.(Fig. 7) Trim away $1 / 4 \prime$ from the sewn diagonal pencil line on both corners. (Fig. 8) Press in one direction as pictured . (Fig. 9)

X Block A


To make an "X Marks the Spot" Quilt you will need five (5) "X Block A" and four (4) "X Block B". Finished quilt size: 45" x 45"
Materials Needed:
Fabric A: 3/4 Yard
Fabric B: 3/4 Yard
White Fabric (or White tone-on-tone - includes $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ finished inner border): $1 \frac{1}{4}$ yard
Fabric C: $1 / 4$ yard
Fabric D: $1 / 4$ yard
$31 / 2 \prime$ Outer Border: 2/3 yard. (Cut six (6) $31 / 2 \prime x$ WOF strips) Borders will be pieced.
Binding: $1 / 2$ yard
Backing: 3 yards
Batting Cut to Size
